The 2024 Scholarship will be presented August 30 1, 2024, at the 2024 AOHA State Championship Horse Show.

The scholarship is awarded through a selection process at the local association level then by decision of the AOHA Scholarship Committee; their decision is final.

The scholarship may be awarded only once to any applicant.

To qualify for the scholarship the applicant must:

- Submit the application, with all required documents to <u>your local AOHA Director</u> by **July 1, 2024**. (The local Director will be allowed to forward their association's top applicants, which are limited to one (1) per club plus one (1) per association (ex. An association with 4 clubs would be allowed to forward up to 5 applications.)
- Be a member of their local AOHA member association the past two (2) or more years.
- Have shown at the AOHA State Championship Horse Show at least once within the last three (3) years (2021-2023).
- Be a 2024 graduating high school senior.
- Have a high school GPA of at least 3.0.
- Attach the following documents to the application:
 - **1.** High School transcript (official transcript or unofficial transcript with letter from school principal, counselor or advisor attached).
 - **2.** An essay, no more than one (1) page (double spaced) in length, the topic of which should clearly be horse related.
 - **3.** Letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member. (Examples: 4-H, FFA, civic or community leader, pastor, high school principal, teacher, counselor, or advisor)
 - **4.** Letter of recommendation from your local horse club president within your local AOHA member association.
 - **5.** Copy of letter of acceptance from a college, technical or trade school for the 2024/2025 year.
- In a sealed envelope, AOHA Directors are to provide a cover letter, alphabetically naming their association's selected applicants (up to the number allowed for their association) and the associated applications with all attachments, to the AOHA Scholarship Committee at the July 2024 AOHA meeting in Montgomery.
